Create a mission cross using pictures of people you don't know as a reminder that we are all one family in mission!

Materials needed

- One piece of white card
- The attached cross pattern with attached Missionary Children logo and name
- Scissors
- A glue stick
- Magazines with pictures of people
- The following instructions

Instructions

- Print the instructions and pattern of the cross on the next page, too. (If you don't have card, you could print the cross on a plain piece of paper and glue it to cardboard.) We made our cross extra-large so that you can see the details.

- Using your scissors, cut out faces of people and groups of people that you do not know. Try to find people from different countries. Layer them on the cross in a way that you like and glue them down—there is no wrong way!

- Cut out the Missionary Children name and logo and glue them on the centre of the cross. Our logo represents the children of the world coming together as one. Their hands are outstretched to each other in faith and friendship.

- When your cross is complete, place it somewhere that you will see it every day as a reminder to pray for all the people of the world. Keep our logo in your mind as you pray—picture yourself reaching out to children in need. Then, act on your prayers.

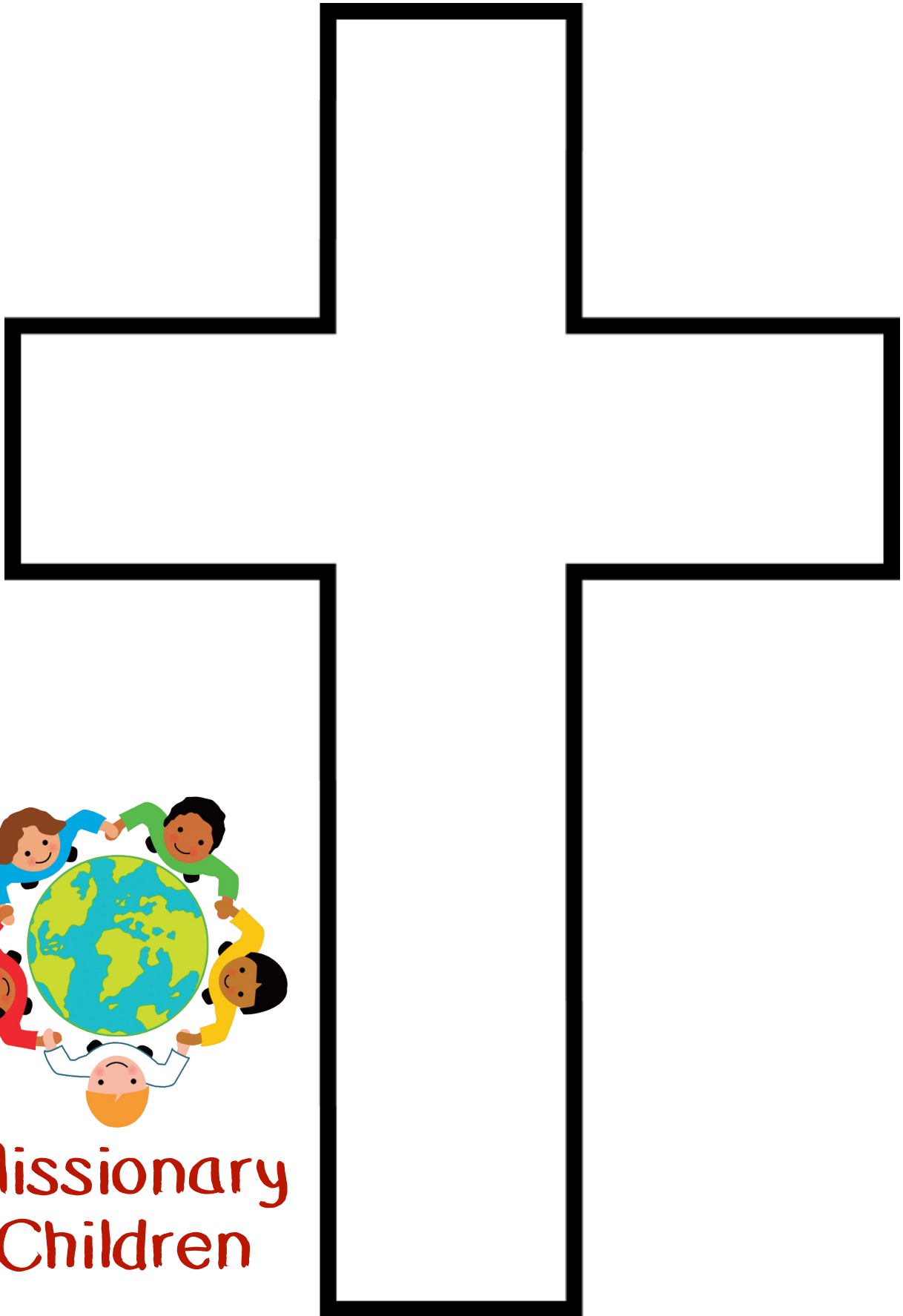
